

Classroom Dress Code Requirements

Ballet/Tap Combo- 3-4yr, 4-5yr, and 5-6yr

For these classes we are more laid back with dress code. However, we do ask that dancers show up in "Dance" Attire. That means no school clothes. Please have them in Leotard and tights. The color and style are up to you and your dancer. They will also need Ballet and Tap shoes. Please pull their hair back away from their face, a ponytail is fine.

Hip Hop/ Jazz Combo- 4-5yr and 5-6yr

For these classes we are more laid back with dress code. However, we do ask that dancers show up in "Dance" Attire. That means no school clothes, especially dresses. Please have them in shorts or leggings and a t-shirt or tank top. They will also need Tennis shoes. Please pull their hair back away from their face, a ponytail is fine.

Ballet- Levels 1-7, Pre Pointe and Pointe

Black leotard, pink tights, hair in a bun, pink ballet shoes (Canvas or leather dancers' choice). There are no exceptions to this dress code. If your child is not dressed appropriately, they may be asked to sit out of the class and take notes on what is being taught. We are not only teaching your children dance but also about classroom etiquette, discipline, and the proper way to train.

Jazz/ Contemporary/ Lyrical- Levels 1-7

Dancers must wear dance attire. No street clothes! This means leggings, biker shorts, leotards, tight fitting Tank tops or t-shirts. It is difficult for them to do what we are asking in jeans, skirts or dresses. They should have Tan Jazz shoes or Turners. Hair must be pulled back into a ponytail or kept in a bun if coming/going to a ballet class.

Tap- Levels 1-7

Dancers must wear dance attire. No street clothes! This means leggings, biker shorts, leotards, tight fitting Tank tops or t-shirts. It is difficult for them to do what we are asking in jeans, skirts or dresses. They should have hard soles, lace up Black tap shoes for levels 2+. Hair must be pulled back into a ponytail or kept in a bun if coming/ going to a ballet class.

Hip Hop- Levels 1-7

Dancers must wear dance attire or comfortable clothing. Hip hop can have baggier clothing compared to other styles. They should have Tennis shoes. Hair must be pulled back into a ponytail unless instructed by the teacher to take it down.

Acro- Beg, Int, Adv

Dancers must wear dance attire. No street clothes! This means leggings, biker shorts, leotards, tight fitting Tank tops or t-shirts. It is difficult for them to do what we are asking for in jeans, skirts, dresses, or baggy clothing. They will take class barre foot. Hair must be pulled back into a ponytail.
